"Nearly 50% of clients we've served since the pandemic struck had never used a food bank before, and never thought they would," said Stephen J.C. Raeside, executive vice president of development at the Tarrant Area Food Bank. "Vistra's sustained partnership through this unprecedented period has been crucial in helping us scale up to meet soaring need."

This September, Vistra distributed more than \$250,000 in Hunger Action Month donations through its family of brands in the communities where the company operates and serves customers:

- TXU Energy: \$100,000 is directly <u>supporting</u> nearly a dozen food banks across Texas, including the North Texas Food Bank, Tarrant Area Food Bank, and Houston Food Bank
- Dynegy: \$105,000 is supporting the <u>Greater Chicago Food Depository</u>, five food banks in <u>Ohio</u>, and food banks across <u>Pennsylvania</u>
- Homefield Energy: \$20,000 is supporting <u>food banks</u> working to meet demand in central and southern Illinois communities
- Ambit Energy: <u>Ambit Cares</u>, Ambit Energy's nonprofit organization dedicated to fighting hunger, set a new fundraising event record by raising more than \$32,000 for Feeding America® as part of national Hunger Action Month during the company's annual conference, AMBITION 2020

In total, 25 food banks and non-profits received funding through Vistra's commitment to Hunger Action Month and its pledge to support the communities it serves during the ongoing pandemic.
